The Commuter Rail Maintenance Facility (CRMF) is a design-build project with PCL Construction Services, Inc. managing the construction efforts and Gennett Fleming, Inc. providing the design. The 230,000 SF commuter rail maintenance facility is part of the larger Eagle P3 program (installing commuter rail system through Denver) led by Denver Transit Partners (DTP).

The building has a concrete footing and grade beam system set on caissons with structural steel as the primary frame. Exterior walls were constructed with insulated metal panels, curtain wall, and masonry. The building consists of four levels of office and workshop areas (one below grade) and a 35 foot tall maintenance bay. The project includes all equipment necessary to maintain the commuter rail vehicles. The project is designed to meet a LEED Silver rating.

CRMF will be operated by DTP and the Regional Transportation District (RTD) to store and maintain FasTrack vehicles from the Gold Lines, East Corridor, Northwest Rail, and North Metro. The first commuter rail vehicles are scheduled to arrive in the facility in September of 2014.
