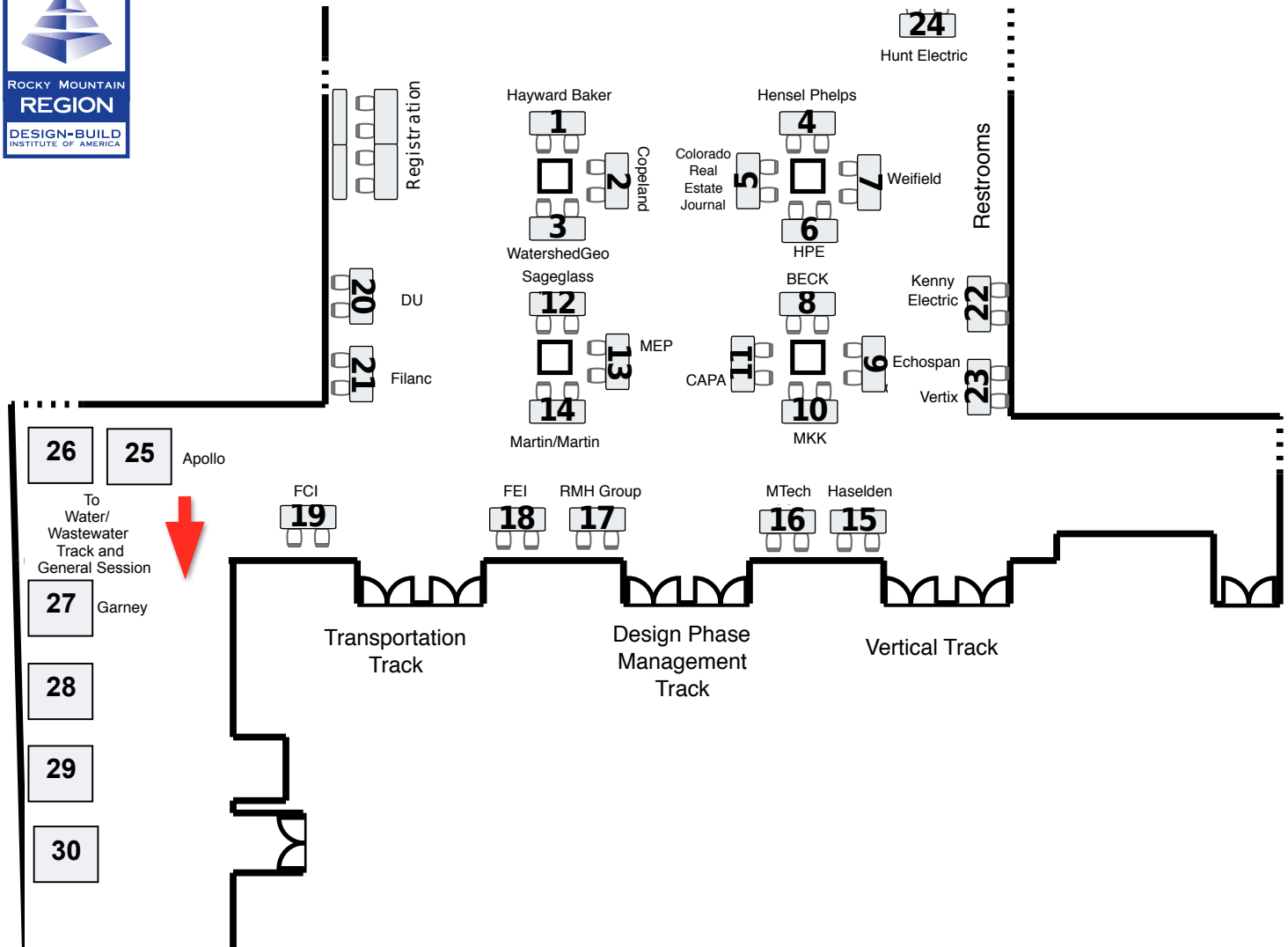
General Terms:
